WHANGANUI-MANAWATU SEASONAL WORK CALENDAR: 2023

Named after the two significant catchments of the Manawatu River and the Whanganui river, this central North Island region encompasses a wide area and includes a large proportion of its pastoral land. While only having 8% of the country's 45,000-hectare vegetable-growing land, the Manawatū-Whanganui region grows 26% of New Zealand's asparagus, 20% of its lettuce, 19% of its brassicas (broccoli, cabbage and cauliflower), and 10% of its carrots and potatoes.
